



## Donations FAQ

### **Q: Is my gift tax-deductible?**

Yes. Eagle Ridge Academy is a registered non-profit 501c3 organizations. Gifts are tax-deductible to the extent allowed by law. Cash gifts are 100 percent tax-deductible if no goods or services are received in return. In-kind donation value is determined by donor. Portions of event donations may be deductible if the price of ticket or event is less than its fair market value.

### **Q: How will my donation be used?**

Donations will support Eagle Ridge Academy's highest priorities unless otherwise specified by donor. The Case for Support identifies highest priority needs and wish lists for the Academy, and is approved the Board of Directors. Donations may be restricted by the donor and specified for how it will be used. In-kind donations are also welcome.

### **Q: Do you accept in-kind donations?**

Yes—if there is a determined need at Eagle Ridge Academy. The Academy has an approved list of needs available upon request. Donations are tax-deductible with the value determined by the donor.

### **Q: How do you recognize donors?**

All donors will receive a gift acknowledgement with tax receipt and will be listed in Eagle Ridge Academy's Annual Report. Event supporters will be thanked in event materials.

### **Q: What is the preferred method of payment and what type of gifts do you accept?**

Eagle Ridge Academy accepts gifts of financial gifts of cash, check or credit card (Visa, MC, Discover, AMEX.) It also accepts gifts of stock, real estate, insurance and in-kind donations.
