2018-19 Transportation Letter

Transportation planning for 2018-2019 has begun. In order to build the best routes, formally communicate the routes, receive feedback from families, and finalize the published routes, we need your timely participation.

Signed Transportation Contracts with full payment must be submitted by July 1, 2018. Once the completed contract is signed and the full payment is received, your child will be assigned a bus route. We are unable to guarantee transportation for your child(ren) if the Transportation Contract and full payment are not received by July 1, 2018. Contracts received after July 1 will be assessed a \$50 per student late fee.
