

SCHOOL OF GRAMMAR Uniforms

Students are required to purchase one set of the formal uniform pieces; all other pieces are optional. Unless otherwise noted, all uniform pieces must be purchased from Land's End. Educational Outfitters, or Tommy Hilfiger.

As stated in the handbook, Eagle Ridge Academy maintains an official standard of dress, complete with a school uniform that must be worn every day in order to: encourage students to think of their attire as an aspect of their work, eliminate selfconsciousness and social competition, and foster a sense of identity. The uniform is to be worn at all times during the school day. Formal uniform is required on formal uniform days, on specified field trips, and on special occasions.

Formal Dress Requirements (may be worn daily):

Top Options:

- Burgundy or white polo with logo
 - banded or not
 - short- or long-sleeved

Note: All undershirts must be plain white. Long-sleeved shirts cannot be worn under short-sleeved uniform pieces. Nonbanded shirts must be tucked in at all times.

Bottom Options:

- Plaid skort (hemmed no higher than 2" above knee)
- Plaid jumper
- Khaki pants
- Tights: black, gray, white, or burgundy (solid color, no adornments)*

Sock Options:

- Color: white, black, or gray (solid color with no logos, pattern, or adornment
- Style: knee high, crew, or anklets*

Note: Leggings are not part of the formal dress uniform.

Shoe Options:

Black or brown dress shoes*

Note: The heel height must not exceed one inch.

Casual Uniform Pieces (if not wearing formal dress):

Top Options (logo only required on specified items):

- Short- or long-sleeved polo: white, pink, gray, or burgundy (banded or not)
- Short- or long-sleeved Peter Pan-collared blouse: white
- Short- or long-sleeved Peter Pan-collared knit top: pink or white
- Crewneck sweatshirt with logo: burgundy

An Academy uniform shirt should be worn under the following items:

- Sweater vest: burgundy
- Cardigan: burgundy
- V-neck sweater: burgundy
- Fleece vest with logo: burgundy

Note: All undershirts must be plain white. Long-sleeved shirts cannot be worn under short-sleeved uniform pieces. Non-banded shirts must be tucked in at all times.

Bottom Options:

- Plaid skort
- Plaid jumper, short- or long-sleeved
- Pink or burgundy polo dress with logo
- Khaki pants
- Khaki shorts

The following items may be worn with Academy-approved uniforms:

- Tights or leggings: black, gray, white, or burgundy (solid color, no adornments)*
- Bike shorts: black, gray, white, or burgundy (solid color, no adornments)*
- Belt: black or brown with standard buckle*

Note: All items must be hemmed no more than 2" above the knee.

Sock Options:

White, black, or gray (solid color with no logos, pattern or adornment - knee high, crew, or anklets)*

Shoe Options:

- Tennis shoes (required for physical education participation)*
- Flats*
- Brown or black dress shoes*

Note: The following shoes are not permitted:

- Backless or open-toed styles (i.e., flip flops, sandals, clogs), tall boots, snow or rain boots, platform shoes, roller skate shoes, slippers, Crocs, or those designated as unsafe by teacher
- Shoes with a heel higher than one inch

Hair Accessories & Headwear: Hair accessories must be black, gray, white, or burgundy (solid color with no pattern or adornment except uniform plaid). Examples are: headbands, ponytail holders, barrettes, etc. Students may wear any solid color, unadorned, religious headwear. On formal dress days and during school performances, religious headwear must be black, gray, white, or burgundy (solid color with no pattern or adornment except uniform plaid).

Definitions:

Skort - shorts that are attached to a skirt

Tights – skintight knit hose that covers the waist, legs, and feet

Leggings – fitted stretch pants that do not cover the feet (sweatpants are not allowed)

Banded - band of fabric around the bottom of the shirt so that the shirt can be folded over without being tucked in

^{*}Note: Hats and caps may not be worn during the school day as they are not considered part of the school uniform.
